

The Roosevelt PTSA Scholarship Fund was established in 2016 to financially assist college-bound students achieve their academic endeavors beyond high school. The Scholarship is funded entirely through donations, fundraisers, PTSA members, and local community. In May, we will award three students with a scholarship, one from each of the following categories.

**Scholarship Categories:** *Please select the scholarship for which you are applying:*

- \$250 College Book Scholarship** - Awarded to one graduating student for book supplies.
- \$500 College Jumpstart Scholarship** – Awarded to one graduating student who will attend a technical school or a two-year accredited institution of higher learning in the fall or spring semester of the next school year. GPA 2.5 or higher
- \$1,000 Presidential Scholarship** – Awarded to one graduating student who will attend a four-year accredited institution of higher learning in the fall or spring semester of the next school year. GPA 3.0 or higher.

### Eligibility Requirements:

- Graduating senior of Roosevelt High School
- Citizenship not required
- PTSA membership not required, but preference will be given to members.

### Important Dates:

- **March 13, 2020 – Deadline.** Applications must be received on or before the due date in a sealed envelope.
- Eligible applicants will be contacted for in person interview by March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2020.
- Students will be notified and presented with their award during the PTSA meeting in May.

### Application Process:

- **Step 1.** Complete the application.
- **Step 2.** Essay question: Type a one-page essay answering the following questions: Essays must be typed in 12 point font, double spaced and Times New Roman.
  - (A) What challenge have you faced throughout your life; be it academic, language, social, emotional or due to special needs and how did you overcome?
  - (B) If you could solve one problem in the community, what would it be? How would you solve it?
- **Step 3.** Submit your application, typed essay, proof of college acceptance and copy of PTSA membership card, if you or your parents are members.
- **Step 4:** Place the application and corresponding documents in a sealed envelope ATTN: Roosevelt PTSA Scholarship Committee
